✉ **Mail Bag question: Nelson (Fallston MD)**> I replaced the front brakes on my 2002 Toyota Sienna Van with Wagner Thermo Quiet pads. The box said they have an integrally molded insulator for noise damping, so I left off the double shims. They squealed. So I put one shim back on. They squealed. So I put both shims back on each pad.
